Greetings from Worldshine Adult Medical Day Care Frederick Center. We hope this message finds you in good health.

We want to inform you that we have experienced an increasing number of clients positive for COVID. Please rest assured that we are taking this matter very seriously and are doing everything in our power to ensure the safety and well-being of our participants and staff.

In response to these developments, we have enhanced our center's COVID policy to reflect additional measures to prevent further transmission of respiratory illness.

- The use of masks is highly recommended while at the center.
- Six feet of social distancing will be required in the center and vehicles.
- Please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms of cough or fever, or if you are not acting as you normally would.
- Individuals testing positive for COVID-19 must stay home for at least five days.
 - Day 0 of isolation is the day of symptom onset, regardless of when you tested positive.
 - Day 1 is the first full day after the day your symptoms started

- In the event of a positive COVID case, we will promptly inform both family members and participants who may have been in close contact with the affected individual.
